Nursing Assistants are qualified to work under the direction of registered nurses and licensed practical nurses and assist in the care of patients in hospitals, clinics, and nursing homes. Includes maintaining a safe environment for the patient, restorative care, communicating with patients, and basic concepts of care.

- ▶ Attend all scheduled classes
- ▶ Students need to have a

 - ▶▶ watch with second hand
 - ▶▶ scrubs (any color), and
 - ▶▶ white shoes
- ▶ Class limited to 10 students.
