

2023-24 Conditions of Award & Payment Procedures

IMPORTANT INFORMATION, PLEASE READ BEFORE SIGNING. If you are awarded any financial aid, you are responsible for the conditions, instructions and student responsibilities outlined in this Conditions of Award Statement, as well as the *Financial Aid Handbook*. If you have any questions before signing, please contact our office. The information in this document is important for you to know and understand.

- 1. **ADMISSIONS AND ENROLLMENT**: I understand that all financial aid offered is contingent on my admission and enrollment at Centralia College. I must be enrolled in a degree or certificate program that is at least nine months in length to be eligible for financial aid. I am responsible for contacting the Financial Aid Office prior to dropping credits or withdrawing from the college.
- 2. **COMMENCEMENT OF ATTENDANCE**: I understand I am expected to attend all of my classes. I also understand I will be withdrawn from any class in which I do not commence attendance and have the potential for owing some or all of my funding.
- 3. **AVAILABILITY OF FUNDING**: I understand that my aid award is subject to availability of federal, state, and institutional funding. I understand my funding may be withdrawn, reduced or modified due to funding limitations or due to changes in circumstances which affect my eligibility for the program(s).
- 4. **PAYMENT POLICY**: I understand that my financial aid fund(s) will automatically be used to pay my tuition and fee charges each quarter. Also, I understand that if my fund(s) are not enough to cover the entire amount of my tuition and fee charges, I am responsible for paying the remaining balance by the posted tuition due date or I may be withdrawn from my classes.
- 5. **BALANCE CHECKS**: I understand that if there are remaining monies after my tuition/fees have been paid, I am eligible for a financial aid balance check. I understand that financial aid balance checks are mailed at the beginning of each quarter. I also understand that I cannot charge my books or supplies, and that I need to make other arrangements to purchase these items on my own.
- 6. **REFUND CHECKS**: I understand that any credit adjustments or class changes I make during the first or second week of classes that result in a refund of financial aid funds will not be processed until after the 10th day of the quarter. This means that my refund check may be available around the end of the third week of classes.
- 7. **SATISFACTORY PROGRESS**: I understand that in order to continue to receive financial aid, I must be making satisfactory academic progress (SAP). Maintaining SAP refers to the completion of all credits (based on your credit load on the 10th class day) with at least a current quarterly and cumulative 2.00 grade point average (GPA). Refer to the *Financial Aid Handbook* for more details.
 - a. <u>Census Date</u>: I understand that financial aid funding is based on my enrollment as of the 10th day of the quarter and that an adjustment based on enrollment cannot be done after the 10th class day. This means that the Financial Aid Office cannot adjust my aid amount, regardless of whether I add or drop credits, after the 10th class day. Decreasing credits prior to the 10th day, after payment of financial aid, will result in repayment. See the repayment section. A decrease in enrollment status after the 10th class day will result in a warning or suspension status, and may prevent further aid being disbursed.
 - b. <u>Complete Withdrawal</u>: I understand that if I drop all of my classes during a quarter (or stop attending all classes) I will lose my future financial aid eligibility. It is also highly likely that I will OWE money back to federal and state programs as well as the institution. When this happens I will not be able to enroll at Centralia College until the money is paid back, and if I owe federal funds I will not be able to receive financial aid at ANY college/university.
- 8. **REPAYMENT**: I understand that these fund(s) are awarded to assist in meeting educational expenses; and should my award status change, repayment of all or a part of the fund(s) may be required. Once notified of the repayment requirement, I will have no less than 30 calendar days to pay or make payment arrangements, or the debt will be sent to collections, at which time a 40% fee plus interest will be added, as well as court costs and attorney fees if applicable. See the *Refund Repayment Withdrawal Policy* guidance.
- 9. **CHANGE OF CIRCUMSTANCES**: I understand that I must report any change in my financial or family circumstances as it may affect my eligibility for aid. Changes which must be reported include (but are not limited to) student, spouse, or parental income, receipt of outside scholarships or tuition assistance, marital status, credit adjustments, degree/program changes, address, etc.
- 10. EMPLOYMENT ELIGIBILITY: I understand if I am awarded Federal Work Study or State Work Study it is not a guarantee of employment, but rather an authorization to work under these programs. The amount I earn is limited to the amount authorized on my award letter.
- 11. **WASHINGTON COLLEGE GRANT**: I understand that I must enroll in at least 3 credits each quarter if Washington College Grant (WCG/SNG) is part of my financial aid award. I also understand I may voluntarily, when able, make financial contributions to the Washington Student Achievement Council in recognition of this grant, and that this gift will be used to provide financial assistance to other students.

2023-24 Washington State Aid Information & Conditions of Award

The State of Washington is offering you financial assistance to help support your education expenses. Please visit www.opportunitypathways.wa.gov to receive more information about financial aid, scholarships, work study, and student loans.

As a state aid recipient, you may be eligible for the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) and can apply for benefits through the Washington Connection online portal (www.washingtonconnection.org) or in-person at a local Department of Social and Health Services office. You can also recieve assistance in applying and be connected to additional resources by contacting the Basic Food Employment & Training (BFET) staff at Centralia College, in the Transitional Studies Building, room 101.

In order to receive this financial assistance you will need to comply with the following conditions. If you have questions or find that you cannot comply with these conditions, please contact the Centralia College financial aid office.

- 1. You meet the requirements for Washington State residency.
- 2. You do not owe a repayment to any federal or state grant or scholarship nor are you in default on a state student loan.
- 3. You must be enrolled in an eligible program and not pursuing a degree in theology.
- 4. If you hold a bachelor's degree or the foreign equivalent, you are not eligible to receive state grant funds.
- 5. If you do not attend or if you withdraw from your classes, you may owe a repayment of all or part of any state funds you have received.
- 6. You must maintain the academic progress standards established by your institution in order to receive additional state aid.
- 7. There could be other circumstances that would require a repayment or reduction in your current award amounts.
- 8. You must meet all eligibility requirements for the state aid program(s) awarded.
- 9. The offer of this financial assistance is subject to, and conditioned upon, the availability of funds. Washington Student Achievement Council (WSAC) and the institution through which the grant, scholarship, or work study is awarded, reserve the right to withdraw, reduce, or modify the awards due to funding limitations or due to changes in circumstances which affect your eligibility for the program(s).
- 10. If you fail to cash your check containing state funds of fail to pickup your remaining funds by the close of the academic year, the funds shall be returned to the program at WSAC and treated as funds declined by you.
