Adelaid Dagasso Memorial Endowed Scholarship

This scholarship was established with a portion of Adelaid Dagasso's estate and is for the benefit of student scholarships at Centralia College.

Al & Marge Kuder Family Endowed Scholarship

Created by the daughters and family of Al and Marge Kuder, long-time residents of Centralia. They instilled the value of education in their five daughters. Having lived just two blocks from Centralia College, all five daughters graduated from Centralia College and became self-sufficient women and contributing members of society.

Al Cluzel Golf Scholarship

Created by PostNet – Centralia in 2018 from the proceeds of the Al Cluzel Memorial Golf Tournament to benefit a student participating on the women's golf team at Centralia College.

Alan Allie Athletic Endowed Scholarship

The Alan Allie endowment was established in Alan Allie's memory by former Centralia College basketball teammates from the class of 1962. The bond that the teammates created has lasted from high school through college and for over 50 years longer. This scholarship is given to a student athlete.

Alice & France J. Paulus Endowed Scholarship

Created in 2008 as a living legacy to Alice and Francis Paulus – both alumni of Centralia College (classes 1939 and 1940 respectively) to benefit music or accounting students.

Alice White Forth Endowed Scholarship

Created in 1991 by Alice White Forth, long-time Centralia College faculty member and former Dean of Students, this scholarship is given to a student based on academic performance and good citizenship.

This scholarship is awarded to nursing students at
Centralia College.

This scholarship was created in 2011 and is awarded to a Veteran or the relative of a Veteran. The American Legion vows to be of service to our veterans, their families and the local community.

American Legion Post #22 Endowed Scholarship

This scholarship was created by the American Legion, Post #22 in Chehalis and is awarded to a veteran or veteran's dependent.

AMVETS Post #2 Veteran's Scholarship

This scholarship, created in conjunction with the AMVETS Post 02 Ladies Auxiliary, is awarded to a veteran or veteran's dependent.

Arne & Julia Fagerness Endowed Scholarship

The son of a Swedish–Finn immigrant, Arne was born near Rochester and grew up on his parent’s strawberry farm. He left formal schooling after he graduated from eighth grade. He and his wife, Julia, raised nine children, most of whom attended Centralia College.

Arthur Ehret Endowed Scholarship

This endowment was created in memory of Arthur Ehret, the original registrar in 1925 and later the Chemistry instructor at Centralia Junior College. When Mr. Ehret died in 1974, he held the record for the longest tenure teaching at a community college. This endowment was established in 1983 by the Centralia College Foundation Board of Directors for students studying Chemistry.

Arthur Freeman Staeger & Kathryn Staeger Kimball Endowed Scholarship

This endowment was established to benefit students attending Centralia College through general scholarships.

Arthur Plummer Endowed Scholarship

This scholarship was created to benefit students attending Centralia College through a general scholarship.

Atara MacNamara Nursing Scholarship

This scholarship was created by Atara MacNamara to benefit a second year nursing student at Centralia College.

Ashmore Family & Friends Athletic Scholarship

Created by the Ashmore family through their continued support of the annual Seattle to Portland bike ride, in recognition of an outstanding student athlete from our service area.

Beverly Noyes Scholarship

Funded by the Centralia College TRiO Club, Beverly Noyes exemplified the Helping Hand Spirit of TRiO. Generosity, “the quality of being kind and generous,” encompasses the essence of Beverly, who in spite of losing her eyesight continued to support the Club’s Make a Difference Day Project. Over the course of ten years she generously donated her handmade scarves that brought love and happiness to over 500 children in our community.

Bill and Helga Watterson Endowed Scholarship

This scholarship was created in 2013 by Bill (Centralia College class of 1959) and Helga Watterson for deserving students attending Centralia College.

Bill and June Gorter Memorial Scholarship

Created in 2015 by long-time, local community member and current Lewis County Commissioner, Edna Fund in memory of her parents, Bill & June Gorter.

Brumsickle Family Scholarship

This scholarship was originally created in memory of Mary Ann Brumsickle, wife of long-time college supporter and foundation director, Bill Brumsickle. This award is made to a qualified Centralia High School graduate pursuing a profession of teaching grades K-12.

Business Resource Center Scholarship

Created in 2014 by the Business Resource Center to benefit Centralia College students studying business.

Caterpillar/NC Machinery Endowed Scholarship

Funded by an annual successful grant application with a 50/50 match between NC Machinery and the Caterpillar Foundation for diesel students.

Centralia Advanced Education Association Endowed Scholarship

Realizing the importance of higher education, local community members established this endowment in 1989 for Centralia High School graduates to attend Centralia College.

Centralia-Chehalis Vintage Auto Club Athletic Scholarship

The Centralia-Chehalis Vintage Auto Club established this long-standing scholarship to recognize achievement by athletes.

Centralia College Board of Trustees Endowed Scholarship

Created by the Centralia College Board of Trustees to honor students for their community involvement or leadership skills.

Centralia College Board of Trustees Scholarship

Established by the Board of Trustees for students who are valedictorians and salutatorians.

Centralia College Booster Club Athletic Endowed Scholarship

Created from Centralia College Booster Club proceeds
and presented to a student athlete.

Centralia College Faculty Endowed Scholarship

Created in 1993 by the Faculty Union at Centralia College for the benefit of student success at Centralia College.

Centralia College Foundation Scholarship

Funded through general donations to the Centralia College Foundation for scholarships.

Centralia College International Network/Club Scholarship

This scholarship was established by the International Student Network Club and benefits international students that are attending Centralia College.

Centralia Rotary Club Endowed Scholarship

Rotary International was established in 1905 and is an international service organization, which promotes leadership among its members and feels that student leadership on the college campus should be recognized and rewarded by members of the community. The Centralia Rotary Club created this endowment in 2010 to benefit graduates from Centralia High School.

Charneski Family Scholarship

This scholarship was created by Jack and Luellen Charneski. Jack and Luellen grew up and raised their family in Lewis County and have always been supporters of Centralia College for both athletics and academics. They created this scholarship to encourage students in the fields of medical care.

Chapter AV P.E.O. Memorial Scholarship in Honor of Alice Forth

Created by Chapter AV P.E.O., this scholarship is awarded to a female student that is in need of financial assistance to reach her higher educational goals.

Chapter X P.E.O. Nursing Scholarship

Created by Chapter X P.E.O., this scholarship is awarded to a female who resides in Lewis or South Thurston counties and is pursuing a Nursing degree.

Chehalis Rotary Club Scholarship

The Chehalis Rotary Club was established in 1920 and awards this scholarship to a WF West student who has demonstrated academic and civic achievement.

Chehalis Tribe Scholarship

The Chehalis Tribe has established this scholarship for neighboring school districts in order to promote the benefits of educational pursuit. The awards are based on academic and civic achievement.

Claire E Fuller Endowed Scholarship

Established by Claire's husband Bill Fuller, a former legislator and grocery store chain owner, this scholarship supports a student majoring in the fine arts and humanities program.

Class of 1963 Endowed Scholarship

The members of the Centralia College Class of 1963, who have fond memories of their time at Centralia College and have returned to the college several times for class reunions, established this endowment. The funds are awarded as general scholarships.

Darold Talley Athletic Endowed Scholarship

The Darold Talley endowment was established by the Centralia Junior College Reunion Committee to provide tuition support for a student athlete at Centralia College. Coach Talley coached football, basketball and baseball at Centralia Junior College from 1953 to 1957. This scholarship is given to a student athlete.

Dave Sherwood Memorial Endowed Scholarship

This scholarship was established in 2012 in memory of Dave Sherwood, an employee of TransAlta and an avid hunter. Proceeds from an elk hunt raffle at TransAlta fund this award.

Dave Spogen Memorial Endowed Scholarship

This scholarship is given in memory of David Spogen, a life-long educator in Lewis County. This scholarship rotates through the high schools in the college's service district and is awarded to a graduating high school senior based on academic criteria.

Dean S. & Elva M. Thornton Family Endowed Scholarship

Created by the Centralia College Foundation Board of Directors in 1989 to honor Dean Thornton who taught business courses from 1951 until 1967 when he retired.

Deborah Meade Memorial Endowed Scholarship

Created by Distinguished Alumna, Angela Meade, in memory of her mother who lost her battle with cancer in 2012.

Diesel Technology Endowed Scholarship

Created from the proceeds of the diesel club's annual firewood raffle, this scholarship benefits a diesel student.

Doctors Elmer, Robert and Richard Phillips, D.M.D.s Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship was created in 2018 through funds received from Dr. Richard Phillips, D.M.D. and is to benefit students that are studying pre-dental, pre-medical, or dental hygiene.

Don Widell Endowed Scholarship

In memory of Don Widell, a Centralia College graduate and athletic hall of fame member, this scholarship is awarded to a Centralia High School graduate who has demonstrated civic achievement.

Donna M. Karvia Memorial Soroptimist Scholarship

Created by the Centralia-Chehalis Soroptimist Club in memory of long time club member, Donna Karvia. The first Soroptimist Club was founded in Oakland, California, in 1931. Their mission statement embodies a contemporary focus: encouraging the best in and for women through education and professional development. The Centralia-Chehalis club was formed in 1937.

Doris & Clarence Watterson Endowed Scholarship

Created by the children of Doris and Clarence Watterson, who owned a farm in Salzer Valley for many years. Centralia College was the first stop for all four of their children after high school. This award is given to a student of Centralia High School.

Dr. A.R. Twiss Memorial Endowed Scholarship

Established in 1989 by the Sisters of Providence Hospital to honor Dr. A. R. Twiss for his many years of service to the community, this scholarship is awarded to a student entering the field of health services.

Dr. Henry P. Kirk President's Endowed Scholarship

Established in 1988, this scholarship is designed to recognize a first-year student who has been active in high school and/or community and who demonstrates potential for leadership and academic achievement.

Dr. Jerris Hedges Scholarship

Established by the 2010 Centralia College Distinguished Alumnus, Dr. Jerris Hedges for general scholarships.

Dr. Nels and Phyllis Hanson Presidential Endowed Scholarship for Professional and Technical Studies

Dr. Nels Hanson, a Lewis County native, was the first chief administrator of Centralia College to hold the title of President. This scholarship was created to enhance achievement of educational goals for students.

Dr. Ralph Carlson Endowed Scholarship

Established in 1995 by wife Janet Carlson to provide general scholarships to Centralia College students. Dr. Carlson taught psychology at Centralia College from 1958 until 1978.

Earl Schwiesow Endowed Scholarship

Created in loving memory of Earl Schwiesow who was a long-time Centralia resident and owner of Schwiesow Construction. This scholarship is made to students pursuing studies in the sciences with an emphasis on construction related fields such as architecture or engineering.

Earnest C. and Edith C. Driscoll Endowed Scholarship

Established in 1995 through a revocable trust annuity for general scholarships. Although Earnest only had a high school education, both he and Edith had a strong commitment to lifelong learning.

Edinger/Squires Memorial Endowed Scholarship

Created by the granddaughter of Lilian and Ray Edinger and Anna and Alexander Squires who both owned businesses in downtown Centralia in the 1920-1960s and had a passion for education.

Erma Kain Endowed Scholarship

Established to benefit students attending Centralia College through general scholarships.

Esther Robinson Endowed Scholarship

Created in memory of Esther Robinson, an avid art student and former librarian in the Centralia School District.

Eva Knight Swartwood Endowed Scholarship

Created from the estate of Eva Swartwood, a long-time Centralia resident, to help students in their educational pursuits.

Fay B. and Mary B. Smith Endowed Scholarship

Created from the will of Mary Benjamin Smith in 1970 to benefit students attending Centralia College.

First Interstate Bank Endowed Scholarship

Established in 1984 by then First Interstate Bank, Coffman-Dobson branch. Purchased by Wells Fargo in the late 1990s to benefit students pursuing a business degree.

Fred and Sharon Mueller Vocational Scholarship

This scholarship is in honor of Sharon Mueller (1938-2018) and Fred Mueller who dedicated 31 years of his career to Centralia College. Fred began at Centralia, teaching data processing and computer programming at the Centralia and Olympia campuses. He then served as assistant director and later, Director of the Garrett Heyns Educational Center. This scholarship is to benefit a student in a vocational field of study.

Garrison Family Scholarship

The Garrison Family Endowment was established to honor the memories of Dayton Garrison IV, Genevieve Garrison, and their son Dayton Garrison V. It has been funded by friends and by the Garrison daughters, Mary, Jane, and Laura. We are certain that our parents would be very pleased to support the college and the community in this manner while helping students to pursue their educational goals.

George and Mary Jane Washington Scholarship

The George Washington Bicentennial Committee established the George and Mary Jane Washington Endowment to benefit students that have shown dedication to bettering their community while pursuing education to better their own circumstances. This scholarship was established in 2018.

George Gablehouse Athletic Endowed Scholarship

Created in 2014 to honor longtime coach and Centralia College Athletic Director, George Gablehouse.

George Godding/EDC Endowed Scholarship

Created by the Lewis County Economic Development Council in 2000 to honor the founding president of the Lewis County EDC to assist students in the Centralia College service district.

George Steffensen Nursing Scholarship

This scholarship was created to support students majoring in nursing.

Glenn W. and Marjorie V. Bennett Endowed Scholarship

Established by Marjorie in 2005 in memory of Glenn, a Chehalis High School graduate. This scholarship is to benefit students graduating from Lewis County high schools.

Gordon Aadland Memorial Endowed Scholarship

Created in 2014 in memory of Gordon Aadland, former Public Information Officer at Centralia College, author of “Saturday’s Child” in the Saturday issue of The Chronicle and advocate for Centralia College in the community.

Gordon Sweany Endowed Scholarship

Created in 2005 by Alta Sweany in memory of her husband and Centralia College's first Distinguished Alumni ('78), Gordon Sweany, to assist students with an interest in the field of business or law.

Harold J. O'Connor Endowed Scholarship

Created in 1988 in memory of Harold O'Connor, a 1930 graduate of Centralia College, to benefit students in the sciences.

Harry and Margaret Shields, Sue Shields Whorton and Delbert Whorton Nursing Scholarship

This scholarship was created in 2018 in honor of Harry and Margaret for their community service in Lewis County and who always encouraged their daughter's higher education endeavors. The scholarship award benefits students majoring in nursing.

Harry Hill Athletic Endowed Scholarship

Created in 1997 as a result of his bequest, Harry S. Hill, Jr. provided funds to benefit Centralia College athletes.

Helen O'Connor Endowed Scholarship

Created in 1988 in memory of Helen O'Connor this scholarship is awarded to students in the field of teaching or nursing.

Hoa Van Vu Memorial Endowed Scholarship

Established in 2011 by the six children of Hoa Vu in memory of their father after the children and their mother immigrated to the United States when they escaped Vietnam in 1975.

HUB Northwest Insurance Scholarship

Created by HUB Northwest Insurance (formerly Virgil R. Lee Insurance of Chehalis), this scholarship benefits students pursuing a business major from Chehalis, Centralia, Pe Ell, Adna, White Pass, or Oakville high schools.

Jack and Agnes Miller Endowed Scholarship

The children of Jack and Agnes Miller established this endowment in their parent's memory. The couple owned Miller's Grocery Store in the Oakville area from 1945 to 1968. The couple later moved to Scott Lake where Jack worked in the state legislature serving as a security officer. This scholarship is given to promote student success.

James Ritter Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship was created in 2017 in memory of James Ritter. James worked as a custodian at Centralia College from 1982 to 2005. This scholarship is awarded to a student in the field of forestry, land/game management, or teaching.

Jeanette Spiegelberg Leadership Scholarship

The college's Leadership Application Group, consisting of current faculty and staff who have completed the college's leadership program, hold fundraisers throughout the year to fund this scholarship. The group created this scholarship in 2013 to be awarded to a student studying public service, social service, or leadership in memory of past Centralia College employee and participant of the Leadership Application Group, Jeanette Spiegelberg.

Jerry Robinson Endowed Scholarship

Created in 1999 in memory of long-time Centralia resident and alumnus of Centralia College, Jerry Robinson.

Jim Ward and Laura Barner Ward Endowed Scholarship

Established in 1986 from the estate of Laura Barner Ward for scholarships to benefit Centralia College students in general education or nursing.

Joe Sidorski Scholarship

Created in 2010 by Joe Sidorski, a long-time member of the local community and supporter of education and the arts at Centralia College.

J.O. & Lillian Taylor Davis Endowed Scholarship

Established from a bequest to provide scholarships for students pursuing a degree in the field of engineering or medicine.

John & Donna Karvia Endowed Scholarship

Established in 1994 for general scholarships. John is an alumnus of Centralia College, class of 1953 and Donna is a former Centralia College Foundation board member.

John & Kay Raupp Scholarship

This scholarship was created in 2015 by John and Kay Raupp, owners of the Shamrock Hill Nursery in Winlock for a graduate of Winlock High School attending Centralia College.

John H. Markham Athletic Endowed Scholarship

The John H. Markham athletic scholarship was established to provide support for students in pursuing an associate degree.

John H. Markham Endowed Scholarship

The John H. Markham scholarship was established to provide support for students in pursuing an associate degree.

John V. Griel Endowed Scholarship

Created in honor of past faculty member, Vic Griel, in 1993 for student success.

Judith Greeley Henderickson Nursing Scholarship

Created by Judith Greeley Hendrickson, a 1960 graduate of Centralia College, in support of Centralia College nursing students.

Karen Paull Memorial Scholarship

Created in memory of Karen Paull by her family. Karen graduated from Oakville High School. Education was very important to Karen and her family. Karen and her husband retired from the Marysville School District and both their children work in the education field.

Katharine Kemp Endowed Scholarship

Established in 1981 by Katharine Kemp, who taught or held administrative positions at Centralia College for 36 years. She is best remembered for joining Margaret Corbet approach local businessmen for support of the college during the great depression and World War II, when Centralia Junior College almost closed its doors.

Kelly Cowan Memorial ARTrails Scholarship

Created in 2014 in memory of long-time ARTrails member, Kelly Cowan, to benefit students majoring in art.

Kenneth Kimball Endowed Scholarship

Created in memory of Centralia College faculty member, Kenneth Kimball, who taught music at Centralia College from 1955 to 1990.

Kiwanis Club of Centralia/Chehalis Endowed Scholarship

The Kiwanis Club of Chehalis was founded in 1922 and merged with the Centralia Club in 2012. Kiwanis is a service organization of business and professional people serving the community. This endowment was established in 1989 to benefit academic or vocational students.

LARE, Inc. Endowed Scholarship

Established through the proceeds of the annual demolition derby to assist students pursuing a career in Technical Arts at Centralia College.

L&E Bottling Athletic Scholarship

Established by L&E Bottling to benefit a student athlete attending Centralia College.

L&E Bottling Scholarship

Established by L&E Bottling to benefit a student attending Centralia College.

Lewis County Democratic Party Scholarship

Established in 2010 by the Lewis County Democratic Party for students pursuing a professional technical degree at Centralia College.

Lewis County Quartermilers Diesel Scholarship

Created by the Lewis County Quartermilers Club through funds raised at their annual Hub City Car Show to support a student in the diesel program at Centralia College.

Lewis County Quartermilers Welding Scholarship

Created by the Lewis County Quartermilers Club through funds raised at their annual Hub City Car Show to support a student in the welding program at Centralia College.

Lewis County School Retirees' Association Endowed Scholarship

Established in 1989 to assist a second year student at Centralia College pursuing a teaching degree.

Lewis County Writers Guild - Doyle McKim Legacy Scholarship

The Lewis County Writers Guild is a community of professional and aspiring writers from all walks-of-life who enjoy writing and promote better writing throughout the community. The guild hosts a regional writers' conference to benefit this scholarship.

Lloyd & Bertha Baumgarten Endowed Scholarship

This scholarship was created in 1985 by the Baumgartens, who were very active in the local community. They believed that the future depended on informed leadership in future generations and it is for that purpose that they set up this endowment.

Lloyd B. Dysart Endowed Scholarship

Established in 1993 by the Centralia College Foundation Board of Directors to honor Lloyd Dysart, a local attorney and law instructor at Centralia College from 1946-1965.

Lynn and Lane Westlund Endowed Scholarship

Established as part of a bequest from Lynn and Lane Westlund in 1978 for scholarships at Centralia College.

Margaret Corbet Endowed Scholarship

Created in 1972 through the estate of Centralia College patriarch Margaret Corbet. Ms. Corbet was the head of the Centralia High School English Department when the new college began in 1925 and was quickly appointed dean of the new college. She is remembered for her dedication and perseverance in keeping the college functioning during the adversity of the Great Depression and World War II.

Margaret Simmons Alvord Memorial Endowed Scholarship

Created in 1986 by Margaret Simmons Alvord, a 1930 graduate of Centralia College. Created for the benefit of student scholarships at Centralia College.

Master Gardener Foundation of Lewis County Scholarship

Established by Lewis County Master Gardeners – a WSU Extension – to provide scholarship opportunities for students majoring in plant science, soil science, environmental biology, sustainability or integrated pest management.

Max and Thelma Baxter Memorial Endowed Scholarship

Established in 2012 through the Max and Thelma Baxter estate. Max and Thelma were long-time Lewis County residents who believed strongly in the value of education.

McCullough Family Scholarship

Created in 2015 by George McCullough, a 1953 graduate of Centralia College for the benefit of student scholarships to students from Tenino High School.

Minnie Lingreen Endowed Scholarship

Created in memory of Minnie Lingreen, a history and social science instructor at Centralia College from 1939 to 1971. Minnie was a charter member of the local Altrusa Club.

Myrtle Gideon Memorial Scholarship

Established in 2009 through the estate of Myrtle Gideon by her son, Rudy, an alumnus of Centralia College to benefit academic transfer students in the sciences.

Nana McQuarrie Scholarship

This scholarship was created by Gaile “Nana McQuarrie” Rudisill and Jeff McQuarrie and is to assist Centralia College students with their education.

Niles & Vivian Churchill Endowed Scholarship

Created by the Churchill family – owners of the Churchill Glove Factory in Centralia – as part of the Challenge Matching Grant for general scholarships.

Nupen Family Endowed Scholarship

This scholarship was created by the Nupen family in 2013 for the benefit of students at Centralia College.

Olga Kraus Stewart Endowed Scholarship

Established in 2004 from the estate of long-time local music teacher Olga Stewart for students studying music or pre-medicine.

Olympia Chapter - Washington Society of Certified Public Accountants (WSCPAs) Scholarship

This scholarship is bestowed upon a second-year student who is pursuing a bachelor's degree in accounting and intends to become a Certified Public Accountant.

PacifiCorp - Chehalis Power Plant Scholarship

The Chehalis Power Plant, a subsidiary of Pacific Power, created this award to be used for general scholarship purposes.

Pacific Cataract & Laser Institute Endowed Scholarship

This scholarship is presented to a second year student demonstrating a high level of academic achievement.

Pat McCarty Scholarship

The Pat McCarty Scholarship was created in 2017 to benefit students in the Power Generation/Energy Technology program.

Patricia Clark Memorial Scholarship

A long-time supporter of the Foundation and Centralia College, Patricia Clark, provided funds to a student through a bequest.

Patti Haase Morton Endowed Scholarship

Created in 2007 by Patricia Morton, the 1979 Distinguished Alumni (class of '54) to benefit a female entering social work, sociology, or psychology.

Paul Prescott Memorial Scholarship

Established in 2016 by the Western Region Boilermakers Association in support of an energy technology/power generation scholarship.

Peter Corwin Memorial Scholarship

Peter Corwin moved to Centralia to become a Music Teacher at Centralia Middle School. Always passionate about music, he encouraged all six of his children to learn and absorb as much music as possible. Ranging from vocal, piano, drums and horns. He appreciated all types of music, and loved watching his legacy continue through all of his grandchildren. He became very involved in the community taking on leadership roles, and always encouraged his children to get involved in school and the community. He was a member of the Centralia College Foundation, and passionate about helping all who wanted an education to get one.

Phillip Wickstrom Endowed Scholarship

Created in honor of Phillip Wickstrom's retirement as a drama instructor at Centralia College. Phillip came to Centralia High School in 1957 and began teaching at Centralia College in 1963 until his retirement in 1991.

Phi Theta Kappa Endowed Scholarship

The Phi Theta Kappa is the international community college honors society which recognizes and encourages scholarship among two-year college students. This endowment was created in memory of Timothy Scott Kirk's memory who attended Centralia College from 1987-1989 and is awarded to an outstanding student who exemplifies the ideals of Phi Theta Kappa.

Port Blakely Scholarship

Established in 2013, this scholarship is awarded to a student attending Centralia College.

President's Gala Scholarship

This scholarship was created by Richard and Sarah Bullard to benefit students that are pursuing a degree in a vocational field of study at Centralia College.

Robert H. & Frances E. Thompson Endowed Scholarship

This endowment was created by Lincoln Creek Lumber Company to support and promote student success at Centralia College.

Robinson/Wolfson Memorial Endowed Scholarship

Created by the grandson of Isaac and Sarah Robinson and David and Esther Wolfson to benefit students majoring in business or the bachelor's program. Both families were long-time residents of Lewis County and inspired others to be active in their communities and improve their lives by furthering their education.

This scholarship is awarded to classified staff of Centralia College that want to improve their job skills.

William A. Batie Science Scholarship
